Lloyd Newman Smith Jr. 73, passed away on November 2, 2024 in Marietta, South Carolina.

Born on September 3, 1951, to Lloyd Newman Smith Sr. and Phyllis Gantt, Lloyd was a pillar of strength and care within his community and family. Lloyd dedicated over 50 years to the trade of drywall finishing and also owned and operated a towing service.
