Michael J. Kornacki, "Knack", 48 years old, died suddenly after a motorcycle accident, on November 3, 2017 in Greenville, SC. Born and raised in East Haven, Connecticut, Michael later came to Greenville where he lived for the past year.

Born on May 11, 1969, he was the son of Sally Santamauro/Narcisco and the late Jeffrey Kornacki and stepson of Frank Narcisco. He is survived by his loving sisters, Dineen Bidon (Kornacki) and her husband Dominique Bidon of Acworth, GA , Jessica Kornacki of Charlotte, NC, and his niece, Gabrielle Bidon, as well as many loving Aunts, Uncles and Cousins. Michael was employed by Solutions Recovery Center in Greenville, SC.

Michael was a court liaison who represented clients facing criminal charges and fought to get them into rehab rather than jail. He put his heart and soul into helping people with addiction problems and, in overcoming addiction himself, he continued as a mentor to many of these people who he guided through the court process.

In addition to his family, Michael had so many people who truly loved him. Riding his motorcycle was his passion and he loved his "brothers" with all of his heart. Michael was loved and will be missed by many. Please remember how Michael would always say - "Life is Good" and we know he will always be in your hearts! As his mom would say when he was a little boy "I Love You Truly, Michael and Michael would reply , "Truly I do, Mom!
