Thelma Lee Holloway, of Travelers Rest, South Carolina, passed away Wednesday, October 20, 2021, at the age of 80.

A loving sister, mother and grandmother, Thelma, known by many of us as Lee or Sis, was born in Yakima, Washington to Dorothy Lee Salley and Melville James Holloway on November 26, 1940.
