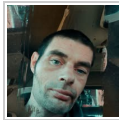
A celebration of life will be held at a future date and location to be determined.

Our brother's influence, charisma and uncanny ability to bring good times to those he chose as friends, was the heart of what became the New England Intruder Alert Rally.

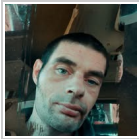
